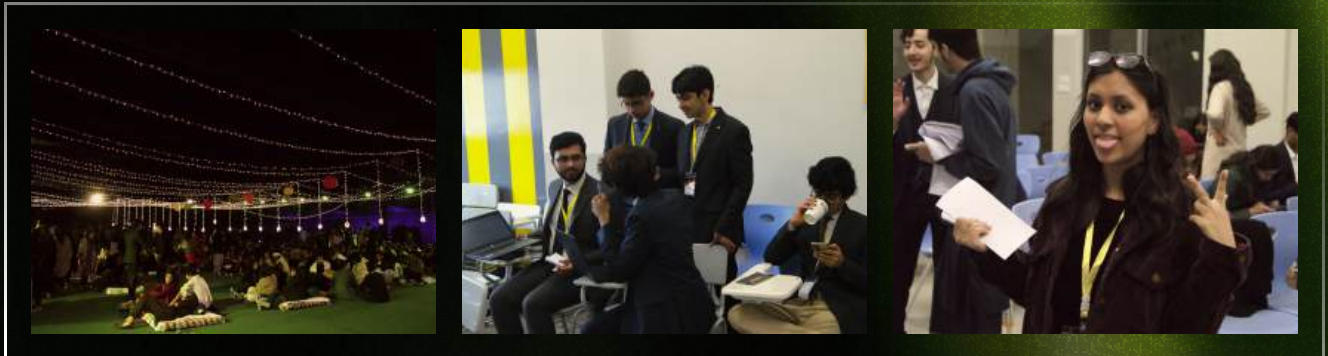
Highlights of PMUN '25
